Internship / Work- experience Support Bursary	Payment of London Living Wage to students undertaking an internship/work- experience	By application and competitive interview Acceptance of an internship offer from a partnering organisation or identification of a suitable internship relevant to the student's field of study.	Compensation from BIL equivalent to 35 hours of work spread over a two-week period at the London living wage rate, amounting to £469 per student, or £234.50 per week.	One-off in Year 2 or Year 3
