<b>Household income bursary support</b>	To support students from low-income backgrounds who face financial challenges impacting their education. <b>Childcare grant</b>	To cover the additional 15% of childcare costs not covered by the Student Loan Company's Childcare Support Grant	Students in receipt of the SLC childcare grant and proof of childcare expenses	<p>1 child: £751.74</p> <p>2 or more children: £1,288.76</p>	Per annum
<b>Internship / Work-experience Support Bursary</b>	Payment of London Living Wage to students undertaking an internship/work-experience	By application and competitive interview Acceptance of an internship offer from a partnering organisation or identification of a suitable internship relevant to the student's field of study.	Compensation from BIL equivalent to 35 hours of work spread over a two-week period at the London living wage rate, amounting to £469 per student, or £234.50 per week.	One-off in Year 2 or Year 3
